**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS  
SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS – CATTLE**

T.B.: All animals must come from herds, which are not restricted, and the herd and relevant animals must have a clear test within the previous 12 months. No Pre-movement test is required for T.B. However it is recommended by the Department that a 30-day pre-movement test for T.B. should apply to all Shows.

Where such an animal(s)is/are being shown repeatedly during successive 60 day validity periods in the course of a show season, the animal(s) may be allowed to move on foot of Permit ER 36A, during the unexpired portion of a valid test where the animal is under test for the next validity period and the identity card /passport is held by the DVO/practitioner.

Identification: All cattle must bear double plastic tags as issued under the Department's identification system, and must be accompanied by their passports.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ORGANISERS OF  
SHOW'S AND EXHIBITORS OF CATTLE 2018**

**SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS - CATTLE**

Keepers wishing to show cattle in 2019 must obtain a Certificate of Compliance prior to the movement of the animal to the Show. This ensures that the animal (s) in question has the necessary TB, BR and BVD tests recorded on the Department's database and that the keeper presenting the animal is not restricted by the Department. Certificates of Compliance can be obtained online from the Animal Identification and Movement (AIM) system through the [www.agfood.ie](http://www.agfood.ie) facility or from the Cattle Movement Notification Agency. When applying for a Certificate of Compliance, keepers should not specify a destination herd.

On the day of the Show, the Certificate of Compliance should be presented to the Show Secretary along with the bovine passport for the animal.

The keeper and the Show Secretary will then sign the Movement Notification section of the Certificate which will then be sent to the local RVO for recording onto the AIM system.

**Please note that only cattle for which a valid Certificate of Compliance is provided to the Show Secretary can be shown on the day of the Show**
